

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Iowa Northland Regional Transportation Authority (RTA), at 229 E. Park Avenue, Waterloo, Iowa, at 1:30 p.m. on Wednesday, February 17, 2010. The purpose of this hearing is to present for public comment amendments to the RTA's FY'10-'13 Transportation Improvement Program. The following amendments are related to the proposed federal Jobs for Main Street (stimulus) bill. Inclusion of these amendments in the TIP does not guarantee stimulus funding. The following amendments are proposed for FY'10:

- ◆ Include a resurfacing project on V-51 in Black Hawk County, from D-48 to ½ mile south of Indian Creek Rd. Proposed stimulus funding is \$1,470,000.
- ◆ Include a resurfacing project on C-13 in Butler County, from T-24 to T-47. Proposed stimulus funding is \$1,500,000.
- ◆ Include a resurfacing project on V-56 in Chickasaw County, from IA 24 to the Howard County Line. Proposed stimulus funding is \$901,473.

The following amendment is proposed for the Regional Transit Commission for FY'10:

- ◆ Change the funding source and amount for the replacement of buses #9711 and 9712. Current project total is \$176,000, with \$146,080 in federal Capital Investment Program funds. Proposed funding is \$176,000 in federal stimulus funds.

Two other amendments related to FY 2010 Appropriations are proposed for the TIP:

- ◆ Include design of a new construction project on 10<sup>th</sup> Ave. S. in Waverly, from 4<sup>th</sup> St. SW to E. Bremer Ave. The project includes \$500,000 in federal demonstration funds.
- ◆ Include improvements to IA Highway 14/57 in Parkersburg, from the west junction of IA 14 and IA 57 to the east junction of IA 14 and IA 57. The project includes \$2,000,000 in federal demonstration funds.

The public is hereby notified that if no substantial changes are made to the proposed amendments stated above, they will be considered for adoption without further public comment. Any interested person or agency is invited to attend this hearing and speak for or against the amendments. Written comments will be accepted at the Iowa Northland Regional Council of Governments, 229 E. Park Avenue, Waterloo, Iowa 50703, through the time and date of the hearing as specified above.
