The Waterloo Housing Trust Fund (WHTF) Board of Directors is providing notice that it is now accepting applications for funding, related to three (3) broad housing service areas. All projects are to be conducted within the City of Waterloo, Iowa. Specifically, funding is available for the following three activity areas:

Activity One: Emergency Shelter and Transitional Housing Services; Activity Two: Owner Occupied Rehabilitation and Repair; and Activity Three: Housing Rehabilitation for Accessibility

Application forms may be downloaded at <u>www.inrcog.org</u>. The WHTF is accepting applications from agencies who provide assistance to low-to-moderate income Waterloo households or individuals with various housing related programs. Applicants who have questions about the application process or would like a packet emailed to them may contact Cindy Knox at (319) 235-0311. Applications must be received no later than: NOON (12:00 PM), March 21, 2025. Late applications will not be reviewed or considered.

A sub-committee of the WHTF Board of Directors shall review all applications submitted by the deadline and make a recommendation of award to the full Board of Directors. The WHTF Board reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, including those that do not provide adequate information to determine if the applicant has the administrative capacity to complete the activity in a timely manner.

All entities awarded funds will be required to sign a contract with the WHTF outlining the terms of the agreement, project expectations and deadline for completion of the activity. The agencies/organizations will be expected to complete their proposed activity by September 30, 2026.
